CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
Thursday April 13, 2023
6:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER

The April 13, 2023, regular meeting of the Board of Alderman of the City of New Madrid was called to order at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Kevin Lyons presiding. Alderman White, Alderman Riley, Alderman Keene, Alderman Cravens and Alderman McSpadden were present. Alderman Chism was absent.

A. Approval of minutes

He does not want people to come here, and trash be something they notice. The council agrees and feels it is a concern, but we are not sure how we stop it. He was also concerned that the plastic may get in a cotton picker.

C. Old Business

Full force main replacement- best course of action for repairs would be to move the entire main to our property and out of the levy and upgrade the lines. Our next step would be to get it surveyed and get a timeline for repairs.

Selling of the Ford fire truck to Scott County rural fire department they want to purchase our 1991 truck for \$10,000. It has been repaired and is ready to sell.
